Construction A COLLABORATIVE APPROACH

Cannon provided construction management, inspection, construction staking, and materials testing for the Golden Hill Road / Union Road Intersection Roundabout. The scope of work included full depth reclamation and installation of new waterlines, sewer, fiber conduits, streetlights, landscaping, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, roadwork, and signage and striping.

As the first "dog bone" style roundabout in San Luis Obispo County, the project presented unique challenges for the team. Cannon supported with coordination and phasing of detour routes throughout the City to facilitate the full intersection closure. We also provided layout and staking for the roundabout's unique geometry and coordinated emergency vehicle accommodations during construction.

The project alleviated traffic congestion and supported future transportation-related growth, including oversized, nine-axle transports. In addition, by closing the intersection in its entirety for the duration of the project, the City was able to save millions of dollars in construction costs.

Throughout the duration of the project, the City, Cannon, Wallace, and the awarded contractor maintained a highly cooperative and collaborative work environment, resulting in the safe and successful delivery of a quality project on behalf of the City.
